

VARIOUS COUNTY & SECTION COMPETITION BYELAWS

Bowls Devon - Section One

TOP CLUB COMPETITION

The Competition shall be open to one entry from each affiliated Club, and the Game shall be played by a team of eleven players on each side. The home Captain will inform the away Captain of the five rink numbers in play for the game. The away Captain will place their cards face down and will mix them up before writing the rink numbers on the back. The home Captain will then match up the cards to their individual events; the home Captain will call for the toss of the coin.

Each side shall consist of players in the following events:

- a) **Two Wood Singles {21 shots}** b) **Four Wood Singles {21 shots}**
c) **Four Wood Pairs** d) **Three Wood Triples** e) **Two Wood Fours**

The **Four Wood Singles** and the **Two Wood Singles** shall commence **one hour** after the commencement of the **Pairs, Triples** and **Fours** which play simultaneously. Unless the two Singles are played on the same rink, the singles players shall be ready to play **15 minutes** before this time.

Each event shall be played to a result. Should the Pairs, Triples or Fours tie, an extra end will be played. **One point awarded** to the winner of each game. The team with the most points proceeds to the next round.

A player may only play in one game per round, after each round the winning Club can play other members or switch players around in the next game.

The **Home team** to provide **markers** for the two singles games.

Each of the eight Sections shall play to a winner on a knock out principle. After completion of play in the sections the competition shall continue as per the minor competitions on a knock out basis.

The venues for the semi final and the final shall be determined by the County Management Committee or its appointed Sub-Committee. The winning Club and runner up will receive a memento of their success.

Dress: Dress for the above competition shall be: Grey trousers. Section final will be **white trousers**.

Registered and approved coloured team shirts may be worn for County Trophy, Foxlands and Top Club events provided that ALL members playing in a team are wearing the approved team shirt. Approved Team Coloured Sweaters/slipovers may be worn ONLY with the registered team shirt and providing that all members wearing sweaters shall wear the approved colour.
